## 1) Evolution of the EU Youth Policy & Programmes.

- □ Started in 1996 (4 years pilot project)
- □ To complete other mechanisms of exchange (Erasmus,...)
- □ To offer to young people whatever their background **an access to mobility**

#### 5 actions

Youth in Action' Programme

□ Action 1 - Youth for Europe

Encourages young people's active citizenship, participation and creativity through youth exchanges, youth initiatives and youth democracy projects.

□ Action 2 - European Voluntary Service

Helps young people to develop their sense of solidarity by participating, either individually or in group, in non-profit, unpaid voluntary activities abroad.

□ Action 3 - Youth in the World

Promotes partnerships and exchanges among young people and youth organisations across the world.

☐ Action 4 - Youth Support Systems

Includes various measures to support youth workers and youth organisations and improve the quality of their activities.

Action 5 - Support for European Cooperation in the Youth field


Supports youth policy cooperation at European level, in particular by facilitating dialogue between young people and policy makers.

### YiA Programme promotion in France: Institutions and mechanisms

#### France, deeply involved since the beginning

- □ Involved since 1996
- □ EU Youth Programme (2000-2006):
- 60.000 French young people and youth workers
- 1335 projects of exchange with EU countries
- 3126 French young volunteers sent to EU
- >> France among the countries with the higher level of participants !!! Germany, Spain, UK, Netherland,...



### Main role of the AFPEJA

- □ **Promotion and implementation** of the EU YiA at the national level
- □ Link between the European Commission, the institutional partner of the project and the Youth>> A Crucial Contact point!
- Advise young people to develop their project and propose training (Salto Youth Euromed and Best practices)
- □ **Select** projects according to the evaluation criteria of the E.C


- \* Free participation for the volunteers

- □ Valuable experience to serve other and to work with other







## EVS: a very popular and competitive EU action in France

- Most popular YiA Action in France. Great visibility at University.
- □ Very competitive







# Overal share of French young people involved in EVS still comparatively small!

- □ 18-30 y.o : 10 millions (17% French population)
- 30.000 French have participated to *Erasmus* Student Exchange Prog (within EU)
- □ Alternative volunteering services:
- > Longer period of volunteering or in a country not partner to EU YiA (i.e Taiwan):
- > To increase their employability in a specific

International Solidarity Volunteering 國際團結互助志工服



## Action.1.2- Youth Initiatives

- Projects entirely devised, planned and implemented by young people at local, regional or national level.
- ☐ <u>Goal</u>: to stimulate young people's creativity, enterprise and initiative.
- □ Youth Initiatives are aimed primarily at 15-30 y.o
- □ 2011: 1557 granted projects in total

## An increasing number of Youth initiatives (2000–2011) initiated by French young people



### Main domains

#### 215

- □ Domains:
- > Art and culture (documentary film)
- > Europe (Bringing Europe into schools)
- > Environement
- Fight against exclusion
- > Solidarity (From inside prison to inside society)
- > Sustainable development
- > ..
- □ Popular in France
- □ Stagnation in France since 2006 !!
- Several other opportunities in France (Defi jeunes, Envie d'agir,...)









## Some lessons from these cases studies in France



- • •
- French young people, youth workers, government recognize the use and the success of the YiA in France.
- Importance of cooperation between national agencies, youth association and young people.
- Great visibility of the programme through regional office, universities, schools, Youth center, etc.. Good coverage.....
- but still could be improved in non formal-education institutions and through social workers. Low participation of young people in social difficulties
- Domains of involvement and topics of projects evolved with the sociopolitical evolution of France, Europe and in the World.

- For a successful volunteering experience, young volunteers need adequate information (about the opportunities available, the placement of their choice, costs involved, insurance, commitments etc.)
- □ Language and intercultural training,
- ☐ The quality of voluntary work is also important

□ **Surveys** (2011) on YiA Program show that French young people consider notably that:



- Participation increased their competences in foreign languages
- They **improved their abilities** to **identify opportunities** for their personal or professional future
- they felt more European;
- they gained skills and knowledge they would not have otherwise acquired
- They gained **competences needed for mobility** (either for learning or work purposes)

## Survey also show that:

#### 25

- Volunteering and youth initiatives are also beneficial to the organisations, communities and societies involved in France and in the EU.
- The host organisations and societies not only benefit directly from the work of volunteers, but are also enriched by the intercultural dialogue and sharing.

- □ French Committee for National and International Relations for Youth and Community Education (CNAJEP) > Youth Forum Europe
- Position Paper on <u>Youth in Action 2.0</u> adopted in November 2010





- □ YiA should remain an independent programme focused on non-formal education of young people
- EU should invest 1 Billion Euro or 10 euro per young European from 2014-2020
- To have a more user-friendly framework, clearer, faster and easier procedures
- Should have a pan-European approach to allow also non-EU young citizens to join YiA.
